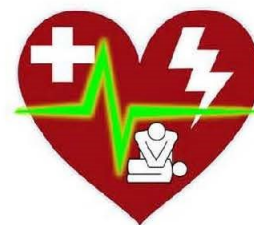



**Where:** Big Lagoon Boat Launch  
(additional parking and shuttle from Big Lagoon Elementary School will be available)

**When:** Saturday, September 24, 2016, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m.
