Coming Soon to Eureka the Wiyot Tribal Youth & Elder Cultural, Social & Educational Center

For many years the Tribe has been working to open a Cultural Education center in Eureka the center of Wiyot aboriginal territory. The dream is just beginning to come together. Thanks to an Indian Community Development Block Grant the Tribe is in the final phase of closing a deal to purchase the old Restoration Hardware building in Eureka. The building located in the heart of Old Town Eureka adjacent to the Gazebo is within walking dis-



tance of the Eureka Boardwalk which looks out upon Tuluwat Island (of which the tribe owns more than 270 acres) Northern California Indian Development Council, and California Indian Legal Services. The primary purpose of the center will be to perpetuate Wiyot traditional arts, culture, language in order to carry them on to the next generation. The Secondary purpose is to educate the general public about the history of the Tribe, and promote an understanding of the unique rights, roles and responsibilities of the Tribe. The center will eventually be filled with displays and exhibits, host lectures, cultural presentations as well as interactive classes.

Coming back to develop and manage the Center is former Council woman and Cultural Director Marnie Atkins. Marnie Atkins, a Wiyot tribal member, served on tribal council in the early 2000's and worked as the Tribes Tribal Historic Preservation Officer, Language Coordinator and eventually Cultural Director. She left the Tribe to continue her education and that she did, having completed her Bachelor of Arts in Native American Studies and continuing on to earn a Masters degree in Native Language Teaching Specialization, and a second Masters degree in Cultural Anthropology. Marnie worked with former Cultural Director Tom Torma to develop the Cultural Center Concept and wrote the job description for this position back in 2015. While we are unsure of the exact date that the purchase of the building will close (we hope the end of August) or how long it will take to open the doors, we hope it will be soon. We have been slowly progressing (over the course of many years) through the steps to make this dream a reality.

I understand that in order to be eligible for the \$150.00 school clothes, \$20 in supplies my child must be an enrolled citizen of the Wiyot Tribe attending Kindergarten through the 6th grade, 7th - 12th grade will receive \$150.00 and \$40 in supplies. These funds must be requested by the child's Legal Guardian and the form must be accompanied by the proof of school enrollment. Once the application is submitted the funds will be released the following Friday after the application has been deemed complete by the Health and Human Service Department. The Legal Guardian must return receipts for the expended funds for school supplies and/or School clothes by November 1, 2020. Failure to submit the receipts will result in ineligibility for the program in future years. Receipts may be submitted by fax to (707) 733-5601, email to tammieb@wiyat.us and by mail to 1000 Wiyot Dr., Loleta, CA 95551. **PLEASE WRITE THE CHILD'S NAME ON THE RECEIPTS AND RETAIN A COPY FOR YOUR RECORDS. (IF THE TRIBE DOES NOT RECEIVE SCHOOL CLOTHING RECEIPTS ON OR BY NOVEMBER 1, 2020. THE MONIES WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM RSTF DISBURSEMENT)!** By signing, I agree to the terms of this document.



- **The agenda was approved**
- **Public Forum:** Received public comment from Kirsten Boyce, Leona Wilkinson and Madison Flynn

Action Items:

1. Council approved 2020 Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Tribal Resilience Grant and adopt the budget
2. Council approved 2020-2021 School clothes & supplies. \$170.00 K-6th grade & \$190.00 7-12th grade, receipts need to be turned in November 1, 2020 if not then monies will be deducted from Revenue Sharing Trust Fund (RSTF) from the November disbursement. In February of 2021 a second round of monies \$170.00 K-6th & 190.00 7-12th grade receipts need to be turned in by April 1, if not then monies will be deducted from Revenue Sharing Trust Fund (RSTF) from the May disbursement 2021.
3. Council approved 2020 Native Cultural Fund 452 budget
4. Council took no action to support McKinleyville’s name change
5. Council approved Resolution 20-17 (Memorandum of Agreement with Northern California Indian Development Council)
6. Council approved CARES ACT Award and Adopt Budget
7. Council approved Resolution 20-18 COVID-19 Emergency Response Program to disburse a one-time COVID-19 Response Program emergency payment of \$502.73 to each adult citizen of the Wiyot Tribe, with no application required.
8. Council approved land assignment holder Tammie Bettis to move property line back 10 feet, land assignment holder will be responsible for any damage to water pipes if any are hit.
9. Council approved Corrective Action plan for 2018 Audit
