


# Bishwuk [DP-kt]

counting (abstract, people, many animals, some objects)

1. Shouwa hulurr?\*  
*How many (people, animals) are there?*
2. Goutsurr. [DP+NR-kt, EB+JJ+BJ-gr]  
*There is one (person, animal...).*
3. Gouwi' goutsurr. [DP-kt]  
*There is one man.*
4. Rri'durr. [DP+NR-kt, CT-sl, JJ+EB-gr]  
*There are two (people, animals...).*
5. Wayits rri'durr. [DP-kt]  
*There are two dogs.*
6. Rrikurr. [DP+NR-kt, JJ-ec, CT-sl, EB+JJ-gr]  
*There are three (people, animals...).*
7. Halou'wi' rrikurr. [DP-kt]  
*There are three canoes.*
8. Rriya'wurr. [DP+NR-kt, JJ-ec, CT-sl, EB+JJ-gr]  
*There are four (people, animals...).*
9. Rriya'wurr tvanughidurr. [EB-gr]  
*There are four woven blankets.*
10. We'sagh (hulurr). [DP+NR-kt, AR-jh, ??-ak, EB-gr]  
*(There are) five (people, animals...)*
11. We'sagh hulurr mulhuk. [JJ-gr]  
*There are five salmon.*
12. Gutsurr. [EB+JJ+BJ-gr, DP-kt]  
*There are many (people, animals...)*
13. Jechach da gutsurr. [JJ-gr]  
*There are many animals (elk, etc.)*
14. Ga lu wulou'. [JJ-gr, DP-kt]  
Ga lu velou'. [WaB-gr]  
*There is/there are none. ("one doesn't see it")*
