1. Rra'dughurr. [DP-kt]
Da layugurr. [EB-gr]
It's windy. / The wind is blowing.
2. Ga biwu rradughu'n. [DP-kt]
It's not very windy.
3. Ga'wayughurr. [JJ-gr]
The wind starts/started to blow.
4. Guduwayughurr. [EB-gr]
The wind blows/blew in (through the door, into the house, etc.).
5. Vouyuvulh da layughurr. [DP-kt]
It's breezy. / A breeze is blowing.
6. Gawidayughurr. [DP-kt]
Gawu lidayughurr. [DP-kt]
There is/was a gale/storm.
7. Hi'dayughurr. [EB-gr, DP-kt, JJ-ec, ??-jc]
The west wind is blowing. / Wind blows up from the west.
8. hi'durr [EB-gr, DP-kt, JJ-ec]
hiderr [??-jc, EB-gr]
north wind
9. Hi youlhi'durr. [EB-gr]
The north wind is coming (starting to blow).
10. Wik hutvu rrayughurr. [JJ-ec]
Wik hut rrayigurr. [EB?-gr]
The south wind is blowing. (EB says "it may rain")
11. wulhagh [EB-gr]
velhagh [JJ-ec]
east wind / morning wind
12. Lhugayughurr. [JJ-ec, JJ-gr, DP-kt]
Lhugayegherr. [??-jc]
The southeast wind is blowing.
