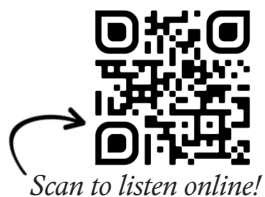


# Shouraqh\*

*The tide is going out.*
14. Lhgawu guduughurra'w. [DP-kt]  
*The tide is coming in.*
15. Hinarr gou lughiduk. [JS-gr]  
*Let's go home.*
